

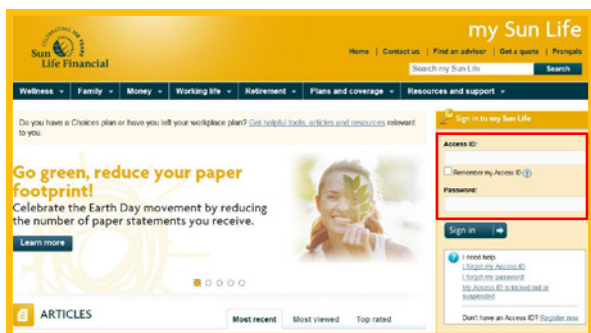
How to print your coverage card

Once you have registered for **mysunlife.ca**, you can sign in to print your coverage card. Follow these easy steps to print your coverage card.

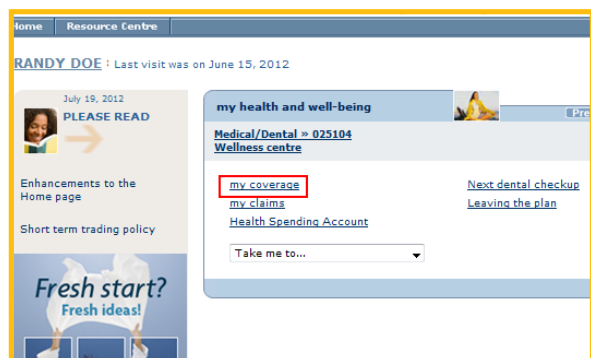
- Go to **mysunlife.ca**
- Sign in with your **access ID and password**

Note: Your access ID number is whatever you chose to sign up with when you registered for **mysunlife.ca**. It can be the 12-14 digit numerical ID or your email address.

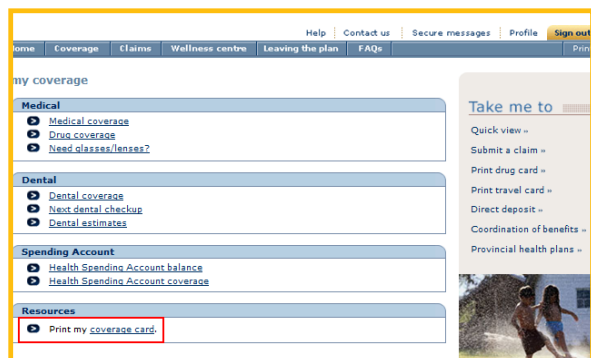

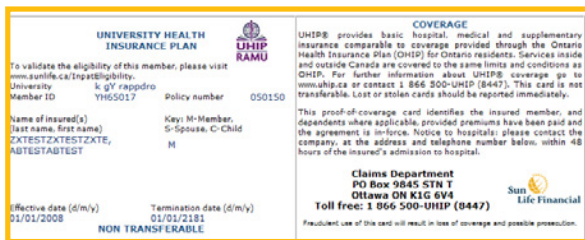
- Select **my coverage**



- Select **Print my coverage card**

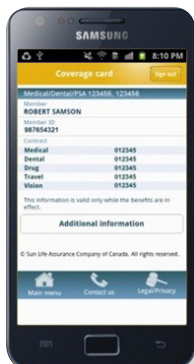


How to print your coverage card



Coverage Card

- Select **print**
- It is very important to carry the card with you at all times in case of a medical emergency.
- The coverage card must be shown each time you visit a healthcare provider.
- If your card becomes damaged, visit mysunlife.ca to print a new version or you can also access your coverage card on your mobile device.
